What we did:

1. Use simple 4 to 10 cardboard puzzle pieces- put velcro on puzzle pieces, put lower case alphabet on puzzle board; upper case alphabet on puzzle, when student matches the letters and place on board, he makes a picture.
2. make paper key boards, bigger for younger children; touch to find beginning letter in name practice writing name.

What it accomplished:

1. independent work for students to do during workshop
2. give drill on letters, color or recognition of shops
3. fine motor control
