Using 8 Cheap Talk:

- I. Sang a nursery rhyme in sequence - across the top - then across next level - student had to push buttons in sequence to hear the song.
- II. Put #'s in squares - when child touched the square it says the #. Teacher showed the student objects - Can count out loud using device or count silently and touch correct #.
- III. Put questions for calendar work

What it accomplished:

- I. Teaching left to right; cause and effect; sing or hum along
- II. Can work independently with another students
- III. Student can push appropriate squares and lead the warm-up lesson.
