I used plasti-dip spray (clear) to spray the top of a students desk to keep her paper from sliding. Plasti dip can be purchased at any hardware store in spray or paint form.

The thin layer of plasti dip has lasted for a whole year. It scrapes off without difficulty when no longer needed without permanently changing the desk.
