**What we did:**

We chose several commercial trade books to adapt with Boardmaker pictures, scanned the pages and created a hyperstudio stack of the same trade book. The children in the classroom participated interactively with the literacy on several levels.

**What it accomplished:**

the children have had an opportunity for repeated access to the story (repeated reading) which has enabled them to "read" the story alone (independent reading).

**Comments or Suggestions:**

This can be done without adding the electronic version, however some children with physical impairments will have less access to repeated readings at the independent level.
