What we did:
We scanned common trade books and printed out the scanned pictures. The pictures cut out and glued to tagboard, were then bound by 1" rings. Pictures from Boardmaker were affixed to each page, as repeated lines, so that the children had a choice in the way the story was read and were active participants.

What it accomplished:
Children became more interested in the story because they controlled how the story was read. They became the "author".

Comments or Suggestions:
This can be a time consuming event scanning the story and adding the pictures, but once created can be reproduced many times.
