Title of Idea: "Power Point Social Stories"

What we did:

1. Take digital photos or videos of targeted "problem area"
2. Place in Power Point slide show. Write text and voice record text.
3. Burn to CD
4. Send home/to class with student to view daily

What it accomplished:

1. Taught social skill/problem solving
2. Allowed for "actual picture" or video of student – more concrete example
3. "Showed" staff and family what "target behavior" was with greater clarity than "Writing with Symbols [WWS]" or "Boardmaker".
